Ice Shavers

General Note: All 4 Shavers listed below are high quality commercial grade shavers designed to be used in the Shaved Ice business.

Swan SI-100E Block Shaver (electric)

- Proven reliability on market for over 35 years
- Recommended for brick and mortar establishments versus mobile events
- Faster shaving capacity better for high volume events
- Be sure to NOT under power shaver:
 - ✓ Plug into a dedicated circuit with 15 amp power source
 - ✓ Never plug into a surge protector
 - ✓ Best to plug directly into outlet
 - ✓ If extension cord required: 10 gauge, 25' or less in length, 3 pronged cord, don't coil
 - ✓ Under powering shaver can cause motor damage

Swan SI-100E DC 12v Block Shaver (battery operated)

- Recommended for mobile dealers (food trucks, pop up tents, concession trailers)
- Avoids under powering shaver motor by using deep cycle marine battery
- Never needs extension cords
- Recommend keeping fully charged spare battery available
- Battery & battery chargers can be purchased at auto supply stores
- Faster shaving capacity better for high volume events
- Your location at different events never restricted by electrical power sources

Swan SI-150 CBK Block Shaver (Black in color & electric only)

- Belt driven not gear driven
- Quieter
- Slower shaving capacity than Swan 100E models listed above
- Beneficial to taller employees :
 - ✓ Block ice shelf sits higher on shaver
 - ✓ Easier to see ice shavings falling into cup
- Reduced maintenance fewer parts that will wear over time

Hatsuyuki HC-8E Cube Shaver (Electric)

- Lighter weight / Easier to transport
- Uses bagged ice widely available at gas stations & grocery stores
- Easier to use / Short learning curve for new employees
- Electrical requirements less stringent than block shavers
- OK to use with extension cords up to 50' in length
- Shaved ice texture not as fine & snowy as block shavers, but still makes good quality much better than snow cone machines
